Screeny GPZ – Zip Profile

Combining the pinnacle of external blind technology with the elegance of Italian design, the Screeny GPZ is the primo awning system to suit even the most luxurious of outdoor spaces.

The Screeny GPZ features a floating Zip Profile which seals the fabric of the blind within guide channels. The sealed fabric within the Zip Profile means there are no gaps on either side of the awning which helps to fully enclose your space against insects and glare while allowing for the expansion and contraction in harsh Australian conditions or minor mis-measurement. The precise engineering and elegant Italian styling of the Screeny GPZ combine to present a very strong and stable awning with beautiful aesthetics.

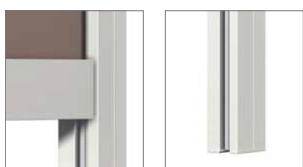

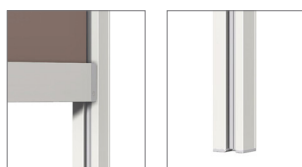

For out of square installations (110/130)



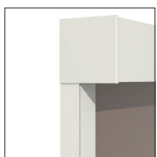
Screeny Storm – Zip Profile

Screeny Storm – where smart design meets durability. Our innovative approach locks the front bar into the guide, securing the edges against strong winds and impacts.

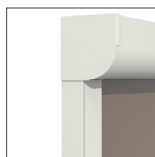
The fabric slides horizontally, guided internally by a heat-resistant mechanism with sturdy stainless steel springs. Telescopic end caps, not fixed to the profile, reduce stress on fabric corners. Plus, adjustable spacers make installation a breeze. Screeny Storm is sleek, strong, and simple.

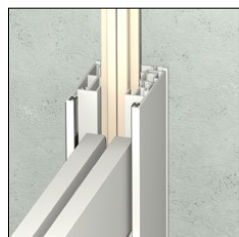

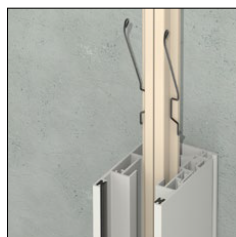
Round Cassette



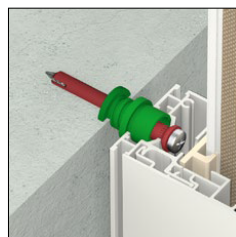
Storm Side Profile
